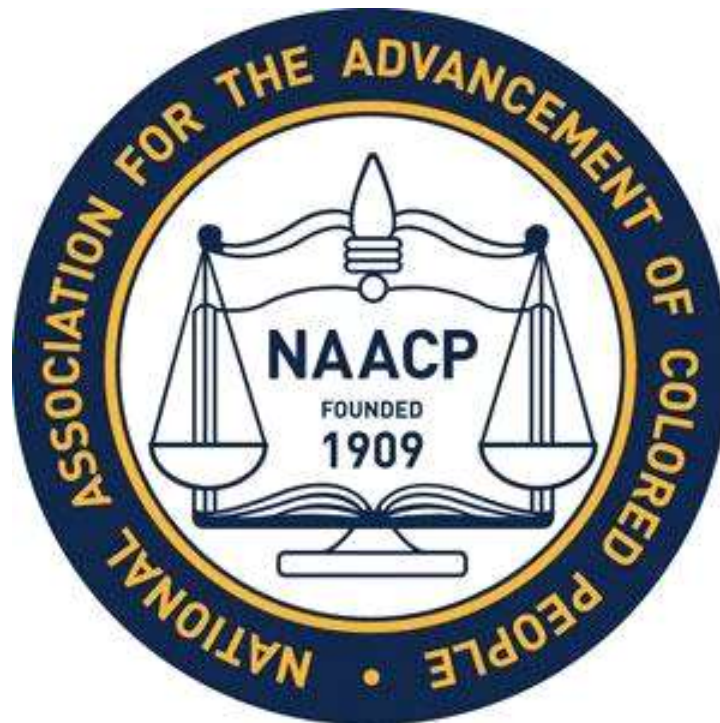


# LEGAL REDRESS REPORT

June 1, 2021



For the Executive Board

The legal redress committee is currently active in a number of areas.

- We are excited by a meeting with several leaders in the Adult Protective Services of DHS. They were extremely open to listening to our concerns and are already implementing new procedures to consider bias in complaints against caregivers. We have established an ongoing relationship with them and will continue to meet periodically.
- We are gathering facts and permissions on a new complaint regarding racial bullying in a private school in another community.
- We have had a couple of new contacts: one we referred to the Corvallis legal redress committee and one we tried to reach in jail, but he had already been released.
- We continue to work on jail accountability in a southern Oregon county. We are in contact with the ACLU and will be giving them additional information to assist in their suit. We are also writing to the governor to ask her to direct the attorney general to investigate.
- We are planning to meet with the superintendent of a district north of here regarding bias by a teacher in the high school.
- We are still monitoring several cases until they are resolved in court or through the agencies that are involved.
- We are implementing fillable complaint forms our web page.
